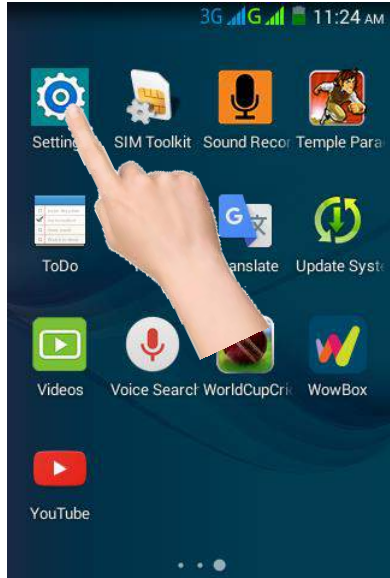
To enable internet please follow the following steps

# Connecting 3G Data (Android 4.4.2)



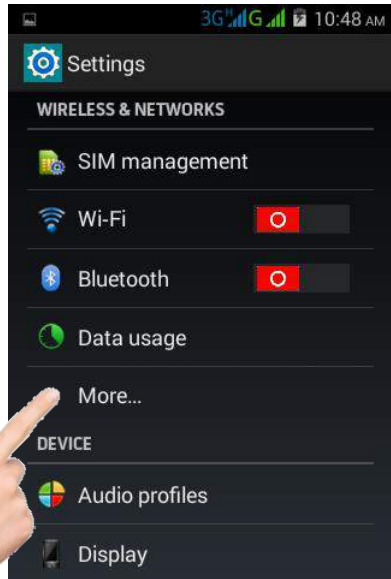
**Step 1:**

Press the **menu** button

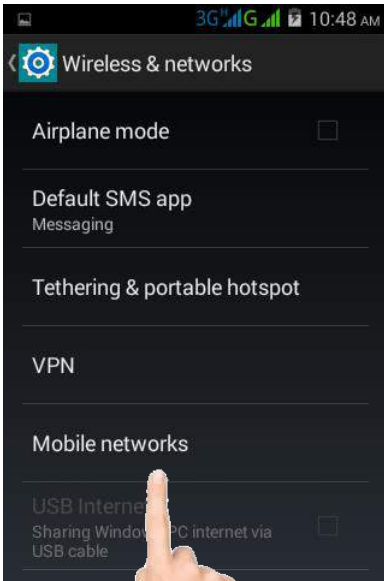


**Step 3:**  
Find **Settings** icon and press

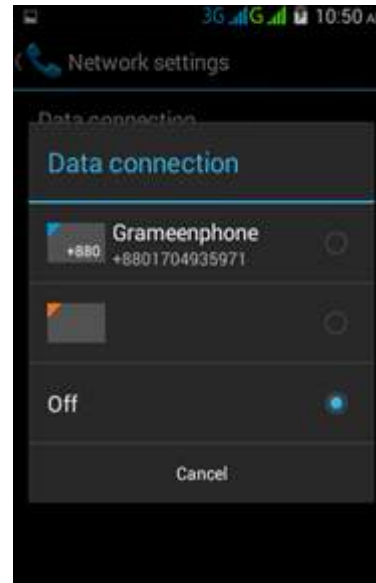
**Step 4:**  
In the settings menu press **More...**



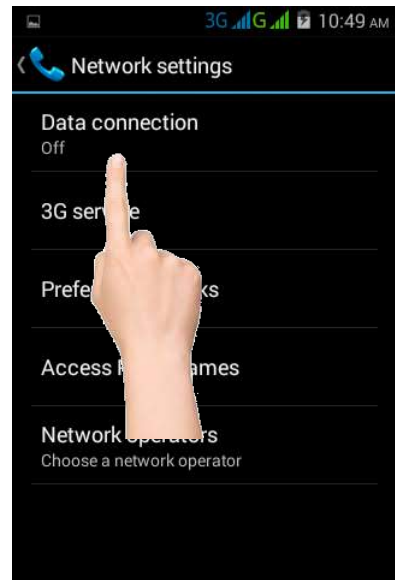
# Connecting 3G Data – Contd.

Press **Data Connection.**

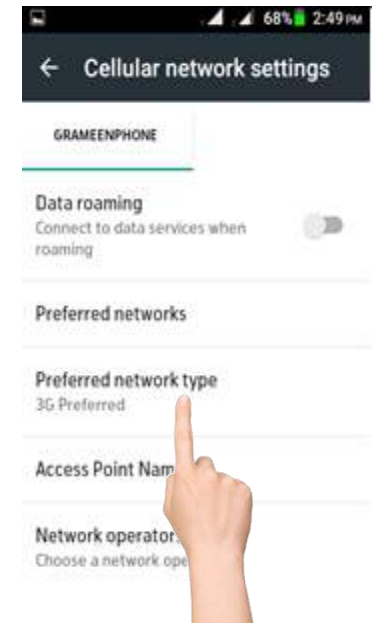
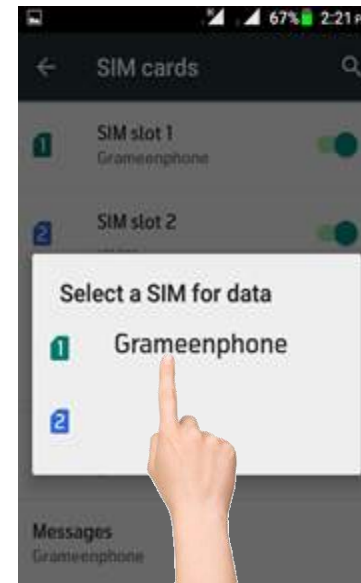
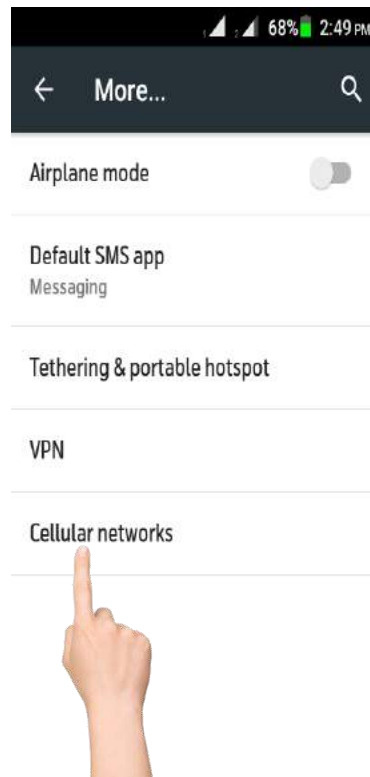
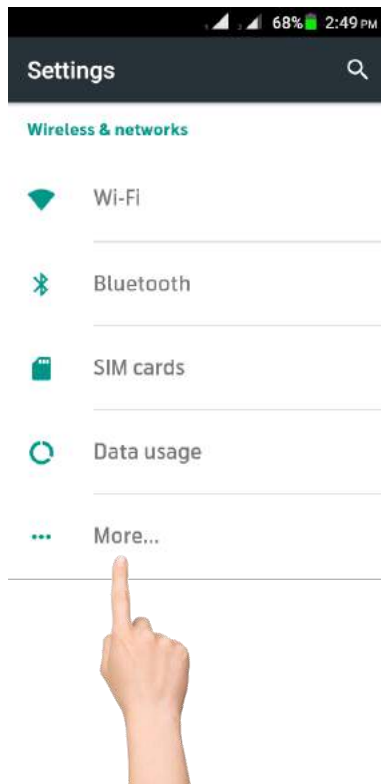


**Step 5:**

# Connecting 3G Network (Android 5.0 and above)



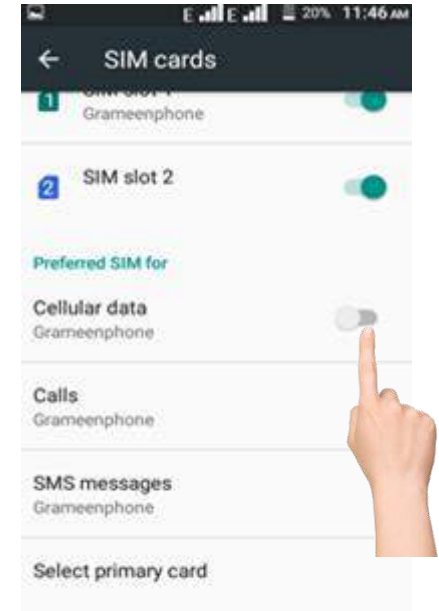
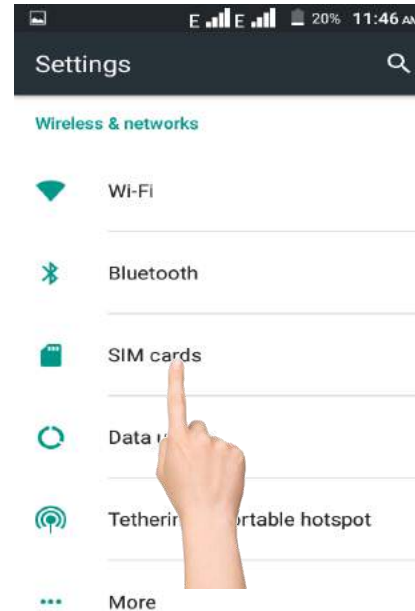
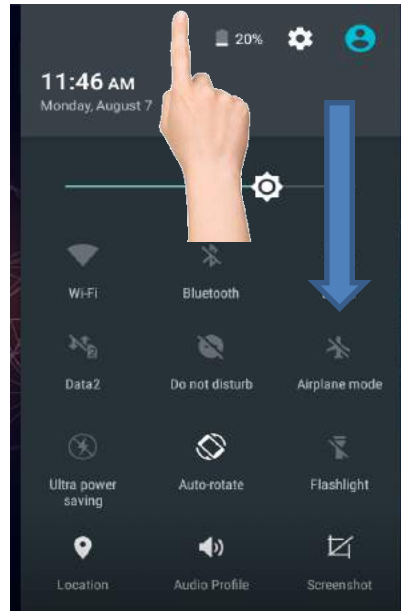
**Step 1:**

# In case of 4G SIM card of other operators with GP 3G SIM card at Slot 1



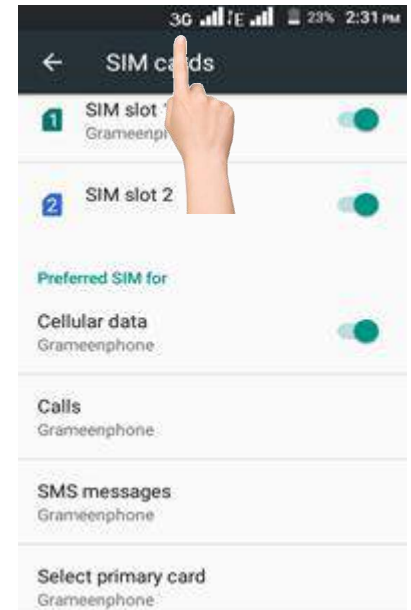
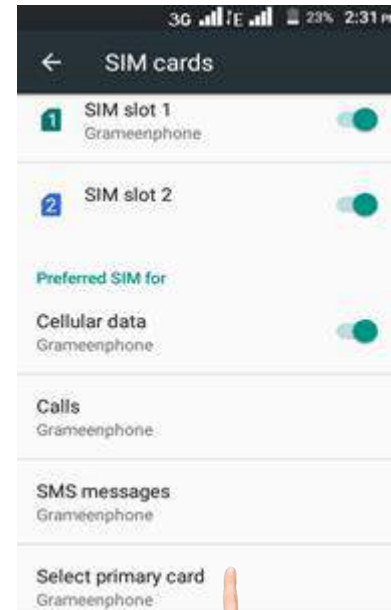
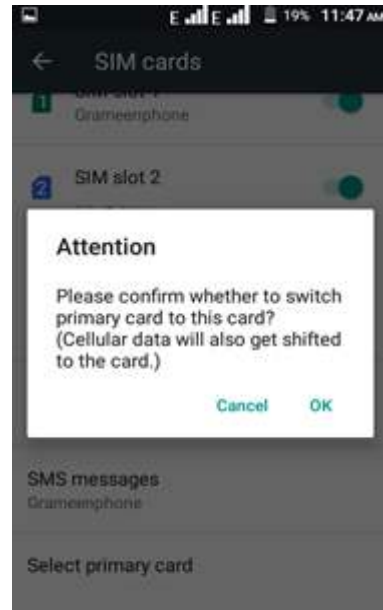
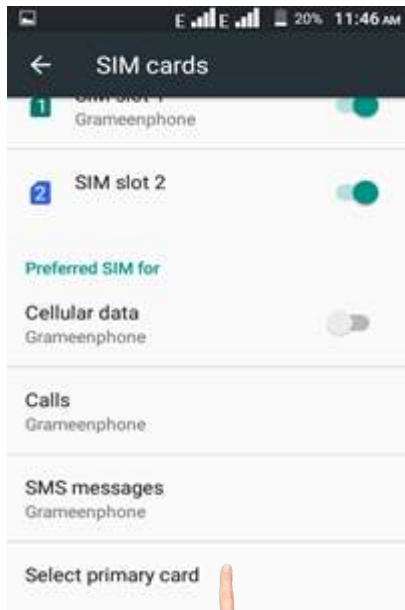
Both SIMs slots will show E/G, no matter in which SIM slot

# In case of 4G SIM card of other operators with GP 3G SIM card at Slot 1 contd....



Primary card will always show 4G SIM card

Change the primary card to Grameenphone

Primary card is now Grameenphone

Your Grameenphone SIM card is now 3G
